Grandma used to say, “There’s a mission field in your own backyard Mary Sue.” Dr. Stonisch, at an early age was shown the art of serving others by listening and watching at home. Going to catholic school, the opportunities were endless. Candy striping and working in a nursing home were other paths that allowed her to see and serve others. So Dr Stonisch found ways to give back in her own backyard of Grosse Pointe, MI.

As time passed and her career in dentistry flourished, Dr Stonisch took her service to another level, through local dental outreach; covenant care and local community organizations such as the Children’s Home of Grosse Pointe, and the GPWW.

As Mother Thresa used to say “It is through giving that we receive”. Dr Stonisch has provided dental services in Nicaragua and Malawi, Africa. She and her family along with her Aunt and Uncle have put a stake in the ground for future generations to serve through their non-profit Chicondi-Malawi. Aunt Ione and Uncle John reside in Malawi three months out of the year and have built a center that currently feeds 500 children two meals a day at 10 cents per meal. In addition, the center houses 40 high school women for four years enabling them to escape the ravage of the village and change what would be the trajectory of their lives!

Dr. Stonisch says, “change best happens one heart at a time”.
